

2017 Mayors Artists Awards

Presented by the Salt Lake City Mayor's Office and the Salt Lake City Arts Council

The Awards

The Mayor's Office honors the contributions individuals and organizations make to the cultural life of the Salt Lake City community. Cash awards of \$500 will be presented to individuals or organizations at the 41st annual Utah Arts Festival in June. Nominees should be residents of Salt Lake City, work in Salt Lake City, or demonstrate their contribution to the arts in Salt Lake City.

Nomination & Selection Process

Nominees for the Mayor's Artists Awards will be juried by a panel including representatives from the Office of the Mayor, the Salt Lake City Arts Council, the Utah Arts Festival and past recipients of the Awards. Final selections will be approved by the Mayor's Office.

Nominations will be considered for the following areas:

- **Visual Arts**
- **Performing Arts**
- **Literary Arts**
- **Electronic Arts**
- **Arts Education**
- **Service to the Arts – Individual and/or Organization**

Submitting Nominations

Nominations must be received by email on Monday, March 6, 2017 by 5:00 p.m. Late or incomplete nominations will not be considered.

Supporting materials should address the criteria listed on the Nomination Form and may include a vita or resume, awards and citations, clippings and reviews, and letters of recommendation.

All materials must be submitted by email in PDF or Word format and not to exceed 10 total pages. Please do not include hyperlinks of websites but full text documents.

Each attachment must be labeled with the name of the nominee (e.g., name.nominationform.pdf; name.contributions.pdf; name.additionalinformation.pdf; name.letterofsupport.pdf; name.resume.pdf, etc). Individuals or organizations can only receive the award once.
