



CITY ARTS GRANTS 2021-2022

The City Arts Grants program is designed to provide financial support for arts programs and projects in Salt Lake City that merit public funding. The Salt Lake City Arts Council places a priority on those programs that best reflect the Arts Council's mission and values.

The City Arts Grants program is competitive and includes a rigorous application review process. A newly completed application must be submitted each year and a grant award in one year does not guarantee an award for the following year. The award of City Arts Grants is made at the sole discretion of the Arts Council and the decision of board is final.

ARTIST-IN-THE-CLASSROOM

AVAILABLE TO: Elementary schools in the Salt Lake City School District

FUNDING SUPPORTS: Placement of professional artists in the classroom during school hours.

AWARD AMOUNT: \$2,000

DEADLINE: Friday, April 23, 2021, 5:00 p.m.

PROJECT SUPPORT

AVAILABLE TO: Organizations and/or artists (do not need to be headquartered or live within Salt Lake City)

FUNDING SUPPORTS: Arts activities which are open to the public, provide a direct benefit to residents of Salt Lake City and/or have the executed project take place in Salt Lake City, and occur during the grant cycle of September 1, 2021 – August 31, 2022

AWARD AMOUNT: \$500 - \$15,000

DEADLINE: Friday, June 25, 2021, 5:00 p.m.

GENERAL SUPPORT

AVAILABLE TO: Arts nonprofit organizations based in Salt Lake City

FUNDING SUPPORTS: General operating expenses which occur in Salt Lake City during the grants cycle of September 1, 2021 – August 31, 2022

AWARD AMOUNT: \$1,000 - \$15,000

DEADLINE: Friday, May 28, 2021, 5:00 p.m.

In an effort to avoid multiple submissions from individual organizations, our Arts Learning Grant program has been incorporated into the General and Project Support Categories. Applicants will be directed to indicate if their request incorporates an Arts Learning Enhancement during their application process. Those who select the Arts Learning Enhancement may be eligible to receive additional funds to directly support their efforts related to Arts Learning in Salt Lake City.
