



HEALTH AND SAFETY FAQ

For 35 years, the Living Traditions Festival has brought together people from across the Salt Lake Valley and beyond to celebrate the customs and traditions of our multicultural communities. With the festival cancelled last year and so many other live events being postponed since the start of the COVID-19 Pandemic, we seek to hold this year's festival in a way which prioritizes the health and safety of our staff, festival performers and vendors, and all who attend.

These FAQs have been developed to address concerns participants might have with regards to the precautions we are taking, along with what health and safety measures will be enforced, without exception, for the duration of our Living Traditions Program.

The information below reflects the latest guidelines from the Utah Department of Health and the Salt Lake City Public Health Department.

Do I need to wear a mask at the Festival?

Yes. Any individual not actively performing or consuming food or beverage will be required to be fully and properly masked for the entirety of the festival events. Failure to comply will result in expulsion from the Festival grounds.

What about social distancing?

Yes. Whenever possible, please remain 6 feet away from any person(s) outside of your respective household.

Will you be taking my temperature when I enter the festival?

No. But if you have a fever or are experiencing symptoms related to COVID-19 or any other communicable disease, please do not attend until you are well again.

Will food be available?

Yes! Food is a critical component of our beloved festival, but we require cooperation from festival participants and food vendors alike to ensure the health and safety of all involved. This includes only eating in designated areas, disposing of your trash in a marked receptacle, avoiding cash payments whenever possible, and remaining distanced from persons not in your household when consuming your food or beverage.

Are there Sanitation Stations?

Yes. Please utilize these sanitation stations regularly and properly.

What else do I need to know?

Our staff is committed to each and every participant's health and safety and we want to ensure everyone enjoys their time spent at our 2021 Living Traditions Festival! We will adjust or adapt these FAQs and our entire COVID-19 Health and Safety Plan as is necessary.
